TEXT

Facebook

Facebook is a social networking service and website launched **(1)** in February 2004, operated and privately owned by Facebook Inc. As of February 2012, Facebook has more than 845 million active users. Users must register before using the site, after which they may create a personal profile, add other users as friends, and exchange messages, including automatic notifications when they update their profile. Additionally, users may join common-interest user groups, organized by workplace, school or college, or other characteristics, and categorize their friends into lists such as "People From Work" or "Close Friends". The name of the service stems **(2)** from the colloquial name for the book given to students at the start of the academic year by some university administrations in the United States to help students get to know each other. Facebook allows **(3)** any users who declare themselves to be at least 13 years old to become registered users of the site.

Facebook was founded by Mark Zuckerberg with his college roommates and fellow students Eduardo Saverin, Dustin Moskovitz and Chris Hughes. The Web site's membership was initially limited by the founders to Harvard students, but was expanded to other colleges in the Boston area. Afterwards, it gradually opened to high school students, and eventually to anyone aged 13 and over. However, based on ConsumersReports.org in May 2011, there were 7.5 million children under 13 with accounts, violating the site's terms of service.

A study carried out in January 2009 by Compete.com ranked Facebook as the most used social networking service by worldwide monthly active users. Entertainment Weekly included the site on its end-of-the-decade "best-of" list, saying, "How on earth did we manage before Facebook?" Quantcast (a California based company that measures web audiences) estimates that Facebook had 138.9 million monthly unique U.S. visitors in May 2011. According to Social Media Today, in April 2010 an estimated 41.6% of the U.S. population had a Facebook account. Nevertheless **(4)**, Facebook's market growth started to stall **(5)** in some regions, with the site losing 7 million active users in the United States and Canada in May 2011.
